WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rio Linda County Water District has heretofore, by Resolution No. 16-55 adopted May 11, 1955 (hereinafter called the "Resolution"), duly authorized the issuance of \$363,000 principal amount of Rio Linda County Water District 1955 Sewer Revenue Bonds and \$270,000 principal amount of said bonds have heretofore been issued and sold and it is desirable that an additional \$35,000 principal amount of said Bonds be offered for sale at this time, subject to the terms and conditions of the Notice of Sale hereinafter set forth;
